

CORE LEGAL/ADVOCACY TEAM MEETING MINUTES 1-17-17

1. Review current Logic Model and update on activities

*Meeting with Drug Courts – Common Pleas & Family Treatment Court have been meeting on a regular basis to help brainstorm ways we can collaborate in working with addicts involved in the criminal justice system.

*Collaboration with Drug Testing – As of Jan 1 the Family Treatment Court will be the primary collection site for drug testing for all three courts. A memorandum of understanding has been initiated that covers the cost of the I-Sam program and maintaining a part time male to assist with screens.

*Sober Alternatives- Family Treatment Court has a small grant from United Way to provide some sober alternatives for those involved in the program.

Due to new having a new sheriff, new prosecutor and new judge we did a brief review of the current logic model and update on activities.

2. Review ideas from October 13th meeting with Deacon

Reviewed the ideas discussed with Deacon — informed reporters. This was accepted as an option but what law enforcement in telling us is that they would really like a small handout they can have to give to those who have overdosed regarding how to get help. Janie and Annette agreed to work on this.
